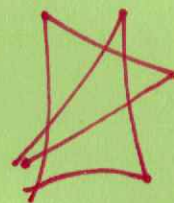

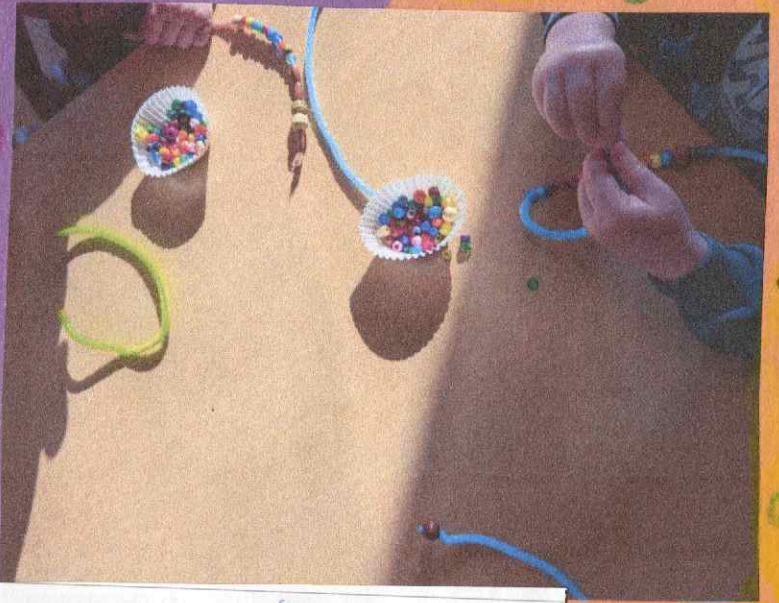
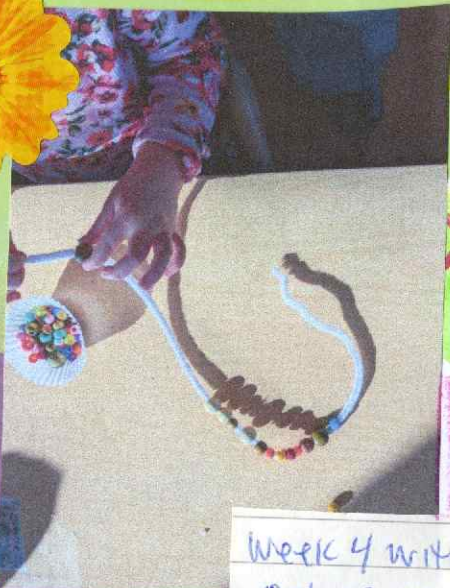
This week a

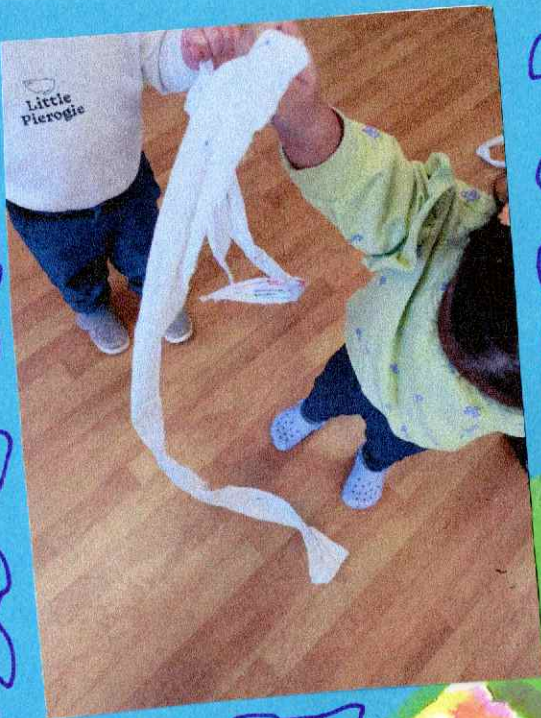

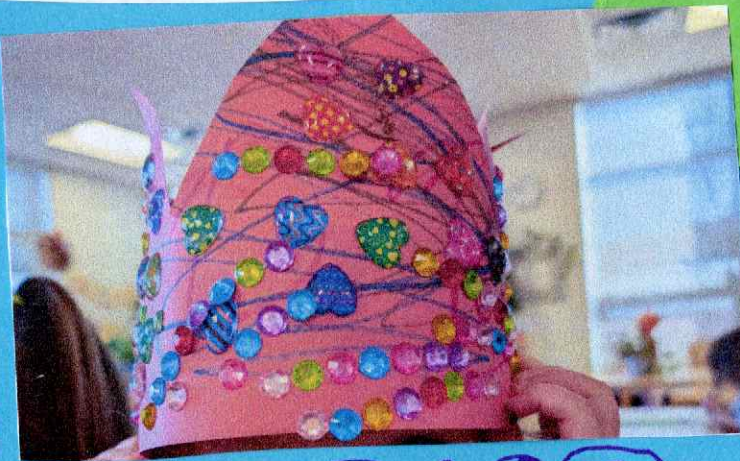
Baffle Ready!

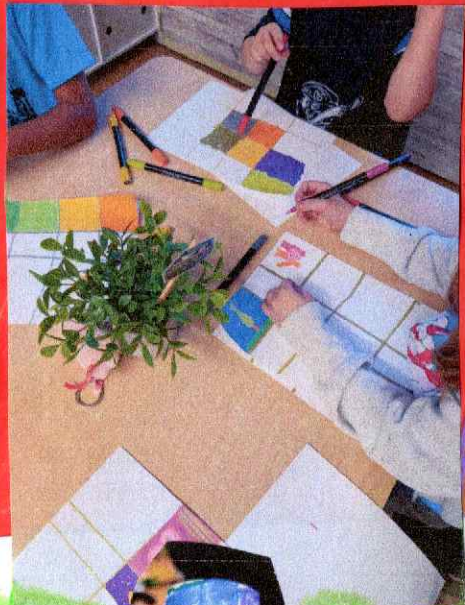
